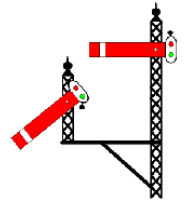

## The Rothley Rodder

Saturday 22 July 2017

The Branch Line Society and the Preserved Locomotive Enthusiasts Group are delighted to announce this summer's evening charter on the Great Central Railway featuring interesting track and traction. The charter will traverse **rare lines** in the Swithland and Loughborough areas and visit the full length of the Mountsorrel branch, including the associated connection. **Haulage interest** is included with no less than **three Class 08 locomotives, including the sought after new addition to their fleet; 08907**. Our requested route is as follows:

Loughborough (PU 18.00) – Quorn & Woodhouse – **Swithland Up Goods Loop** – Rothley Brook (RM) – Rothley (P2) (Change Trains LHCS to DMU) – Rothley (P1) – **Mountsorrel branch (End of Line)** (RM) – Rothley Brook (RM) – Rothley (P2) – (Change Trains DMU to LHCS) – Rothley (P1) – **Swithland Up Main to Dn Main crossover** – Quorn & Woodhouse – **Loughborough Down Loop** – **Loughborough Shed Road 1** (RM) - Loughborough (SD 20.30)

Requested Motive Power:

Loughborough to Rothley: **08907** and **08528** on loco-hauled coaching stock

Rothley to Mountsorrel and Return: DMU

Rothley to Loughborough: **08694** on loco-hauled coaching stock

**NOTE: All timings and routing are provisional and subject to operational constraints on the day.**

Please note that with the kind support of the GCR you can add a Day Rover to your charter ticket for just £10 extra! On the day of our charter there will be 3 steam and 1 diesel locos in use, plus the DMU and other attractions such as TPO drops and much more. So why not make a day of it? (The £10 Day Rover fare is only available to those holding a charter ticket and is not transferrable, they are not available separately.)

Accompanied under 18s benefit from a £5.00 reduction on the total fare. Please note that we are unable to accept bookings from unaccompanied under 18s. All **BOOKINGS** using the form overleaf should be sent to **Andrew Wilson, GCR Visit Bookings Officer, 61 Tyersal Park, Tyersal, Bradford 4, West Yorkshire, BD4 8EY**. **Payment must be via cheque only**. You **must list the full names of all participants**. If you do not have an email address, please provide a stamped self-addressed envelope with your booking and a second if an initial acknowledgment of receipt is required. **PLEASE NOTE THAT IF YOU ARE BOOKING THE DAY ROVER FARE YOU MUST INCLUDE AN SAE**, this is because the Day Rovers are card tickets, not e-tickets. Note that tickets are **NOT** transferable and smoking or vaping is not permitted on the train. Please be cautious about connections and buying advance train tickets. Please note no refunds will be entertained on cancellations made by participants within 48 hours of the tour. Tickets will be sent out seven days before the tour – where possible this will be an e-ticket with a souvenir ticket being provided on the train.
